



WiFi is available in the Library via Eduroam.

There are two multi-function devices (MFDs) in the Library which serve as printers, scanners and photocopiers. They are on the ground floor, one by the computers and one under the stairs. Mac and PC computers can be found on all three floors of the Library.

Homerton is part of the **'Common Balance' Print eCredit** system. You can use your eCredit to print and photocopy at any location which uses the Common Balance system. Check your **current balance or top up your credit** at:

The Library is open 24/7 to registered users

- Over 60 desks are available for quiet study over three floors, including study carrels and beanbags. Each desk is fitted with a plug socket and desk lamps are provided.
- You are welcome to bring hot or cold drinks into the Library as long as your cup has a lid.
- Eating food is not permitted in the Library to maintain a clean working space.
- Lift access can be arranged through Library staff, and height adjustable working spaces are available.
- Browse our specialist Children's Literature Collection (on the second floor) or ask to view our Rare Books.

Our friendly Library staff are happy to answer all your enquiries – please just get in touch!

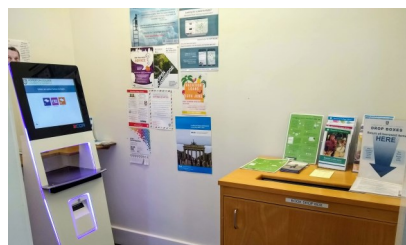
Access and borrowing

Access to the Library is by **University Card**.

For students and staff affiliated with Homerton College, this access is already installed on your University Card.

Members of other Cambridge Colleges or Faculties are admitted at the discretion of the Librarian. Please contact the Library team via email or phone to clarify your level of access if you are unsure.

You can borrow up to 15 items at a time.
All loans renew themselves automatically.



You can borrow items at our **self issue kiosk** using your University card.

Return items to the **drop boxes** or to a **member of staff**.

College Library charges will only apply to items that have a reservation (recall) placed on them and have not been returned.

The Library catalogue

Search for any item available at Homerton College Library and across all Cambridge University Libraries online through **iDiscover**.
