



Guide to the application procedures for a Student Loan

Please have a look at the websites under '[Government financial support](#)', for details of the application procedures. The following notes provide advice on answering some of the questions on the online application form:

Name of institution:

For “University or college name and address” enter Homerton College, University of Cambridge, Cambridge, CB2 8PH, and not just Cambridge. The UCAS code for Cambridge is C05 and officially the UCAS Campus Code for Homerton College is H. However, for the online application system, you might find that you need to use Campus Code B for 4-year versions of courses that can be either 3 or 4 years long, and Campus Code A otherwise.

Course details:

For “Course Name”, give the name of the Tripos for which you hold an offer of admission. For “Qualification you expect to gain” enter:

- B.A./M.Eng. if you are applying for any variety of Engineering or if you might wish to take a fourth year in Computer Science;
- B.A./M.Sci. if you are applying for Natural Sciences;
- B.A./M.Math if you are applying for Mathematics;
- B.A. for other undergraduate subjects; For “Course length (years)”:
- The B.A./M.Eng. courses in Engineering, Chemical Engineering and Biotechnology, and Manufacturing Engineering are four years long.
- The B.A. courses in Asian and Middle-Eastern Studies, Modern Languages and Classics (4-year course), are four years long.
- The course in Design can be a three year course leading to a B.A. degree, or a four year course leading to the B/A./MDes. degrees. Apply for four years of support.
- The course in Natural Sciences can be a three year course leading to a B.A. degree, or a four year course leading to the B.A./M.Sci. degrees. Apply for four years of support.
- The course in Computer Science can be a three year course leading to a B.A. degree, or a four year course leading to the B.A./M.Eng. degrees. Apply for four years of support.
- The course in Mathematics can be a three-year course leading to a B.A. degree or a four year course leading to the B.A./M.Math. degrees. Apply for four years of support.
- The course in Medicine is a six-year course. Students can apply for four years of support via Student Finance. NHS Bursaries are available for eligible Medicine students from Year 5 of the Standard Course.
- The course in Veterinary Medicine is a six-year course. Students can apply for four years of support via Student Finance.

Other courses leading to the B.A. degree are normally three years long, but you should apply for four years of student support if you plan to combine a two-year Part I Tripos with a two year Part II Tripos in another subject.

For “Full tuition fee amount for academic year 2024/25”, tick the box to indicate full fee (£9,250), or enter the amount of loan you wish to receive from SLC if not the full amount.
