Sparkling

Valse Blanc de Blancs Spumante Extra Dry NV Contarini @ £18.60

A slightly off dry sparkling wine made from white grapes including Glera the grape variety of Prosecco. (Italy).

Le Calle Prosecco Spumante DOC Extra Dry @ £22.70

A brightly fruity Prosecco giving tropical pineapple, pear, and vibrant apple notes. This is not an austere, dry wine; it is a delightful sparkling wine for any party. (Italy)

IL Caggio Prosecco Rosé Extra Dry NV @ £26.00

This Il Caggio Sparkling Rosé is bright light pink in colour with a fine and persistent pelage. It has a fine, fruity and elegant bouquet with aromas of apple, pear and white flowers.

Contarini Prosecco Rosé Extra Dry NV Treviso @ 24.80

Lovely easy to drink refreshing fizz made from Glera and Pinot Noir, sweet, berried fruit, cleansing acidity and plenty of froth. (Italy)

Champagnes

Pierre Bertrand Brut 1er Cru NV @ £62.70

A small family grower in the famous village of Cumieres in the Marne valley. Pinot-dominated like most wines from this village, it's deep copper/gold and wonderfully peachy and lush, explosively juicy, it's also fresh and lemony which is such a great combination. (France)

Billecart Salmon Brut Reserve NV @ £102.20

A full and precise flavour followed by a fine freshness and a rich bouquet bear witness to the ageing of this cuvée in the House's traditional cellars. (France)

Louis Roederer Collection 244 @ £100.30

The bouquet is open and rich yet also wonderfully fresh. It offers an explosion of ripe, delicate fruit with intense notes of Mirabelle plum from the Pinot noir, complemented by sweet lemon meringue pie and delicate notes of jasmine from the Chardonnay.

White Wines

Homerton College white, Sauvignon Blanc 2022 Central valley @ £18.80

Bright and fruity Sauvignon from a switched in producer, making flavourful wines for instant enjoyment at a great price. Really great value. (Chile)

De Bortoli the Accomplice Chardonnay 2023 @ £19.40

A great entry level wine from the de Bortoli family, very pleasant Chardonnay. Cream, butter, apricot. Gentle and mild. (SE Australia)

Bella Modella Pinot Grigio 2023, Terre di Chieti IGT @ £19.50

All the fun of Pinot Grigio plus a lovely rose-petal scent. Smells sweet, but totally dry. Great aperitif. Great with fish or chicken. (Italy)

Vilacetinho Vinho Verde 2023 @ £20.70

Some fizz, low (10%) alcohol and a bit of sugar. It is a blend of Arinto, Azal, Avesso and Loureiro. This is the winery's entry-level wine and offers amazing value. (Portugal)

Cool Mountain Sauvignon Blanc 2022 Winemakers reserve @ £20.90

A refreshingly crisp and fresh wine, with an aromatic vibrant style and concentrated flavours of gooseberry, passion fruit and zesty citrus. Flavoursome ripe acidity provides a wine of great balance and harmony. (South Africa)

Dom. Les Yeuses Vermentino 2023 IGP pays d'Oc @ £22.20

Another cracking vintage of this fresh and aromatic - easy drinking - white from the Languedoc-Roussillon with delicate fruit and a bright finish. The Vermentino is concentrated and characterful with delicate aromatics.

Vondeling Petit Blanc Chenin Blanc 2023 Voor-Paardeberg @ £24.00

Mostly Chenin, old vine low yield, unoaked. Limpid, whistle-clean, green apple, elderflower. Fine-textured fish wine. (South Africa)

Luberon Blanc 2023 Famille Perrin @ £22.50

Nice, mouth filling texture, the style reserved rather like Chablis. Delicate nose with notes of white flowers and citrus. Well balanced in the mouth, it is fresh, with great vivacity and a hint of bitterness with salty aromas. Nice length. (France)

Dom. Gayda Chardonnay 2023 @ £24.00

Fresh, clean, cool-climate style Chardonnay. A mélange of citrus and tropical fruit with a creamy texture from some expert oak handling. Chablis with attitude. (France)

Southern Dawn Sauvignon Blanc 2023 Marlborough @ £24.90

Mouth-watering Sauvignon Blanc, with ripe tropical fruit flavours and a twist of crisp citrus. (New Zealand)

Red Wines

Homerton College red, Merlot 2022 @ £19.20

Bright and fruity Merlot that delivers lots of enjoyment at an affordable price. (Chile)

De Bortoli the Accomplice Shiraz 2022 Riverina @ £19.20

This wine is full of vibrant red fruits balanced with spice and sweet oak. The mid weight palate has lots of red cherries and blackberries and finishes with gentle spicy oak and mocha characters. (Australia)

Finca Besaya Rioja Crianza 2019 Bodegas Isidro Milagro @ £20.70

Very good Rioja that offers superb value. One year in a mixture of French and American oak barrels, adds texture and flavour to the tempranillo dominant blend from one of Rioja's most consistent producers. (Spain)

Calusari Pinot Noir 2022 @ £20.70

A lovely Pinot Noir. Light with a soft welcoming nose of autumn fruits. Soft, smooth and spicy throughout with generous soft fruit flavours & a pleasing aftertaste. (Romania)

Sensale Nero d'Avola 2022 Cert. Organic @ £21.50

This is lovely, gluggable Nero d'Avola from a sustainable winery in Sicily that is making excellent value certified organic wines for everyday drinking. We'll drink to that! (Italy)

Dom. les Yeuses Le Petit Merlot 2022 IGP Pays d'Oc @ £22.20

A favourite all-rounder red. Its merlot made precisely à point; there's a juicy generosity, but also a refreshing leafiness: redcurrant leaves and lightly stewed damsons. (France)

Ch. Vincens Malbec du Cahors 2021 @ £22.80

Great wine - juicy, characterful fruit and a lovely silky texture that holds nicely on the focussed finish. (France)

Man Meets Mountain Malbec 2023 Mendoza @ £23.10

A harmonious Malbec packed full of blueberry, blackcurrant and plum and a complex and delicious finish. (Argentina)

Primitivo Miopasso 2022 Puglia IGP, Feudo di Santa Tresa @ £24.00

Being robust at the same time as smooth and silky. Rich in fruit, with a certain savoury feel, Miopasso Primitivo has an abundance of ripe, dark berry flavours and is the perfect accompaniment to rich, meaty pasta dishes. (Italy)

Cotes du Rhone Rouge 'Regulus' 2022 Dom. Clavel @ £24.90

Very consistent in quality and best known for its Côtes-du-Rhône and its Saint-Gervais villages. Juicy, fruity and versatile Southern Rhone red from Claire Clavel whose vineyards lie in Saint Gervais, one of the 'Villages' of the Cotes du Rhone. (France)

Montalto Collezione di Famiglia Syrah 2022 Terre Siciliane @ £26.00

Vivid black, purple, all the tarry plum-skin beauty of Syrah with cinnamon and a bit of vanilla oak, best of all a proudly generous portion of ripe tannin to hold it all together. (Italy)

Rosé Wines

Pinot Grigio Rose 2023 Bella Modella @ £19.40

This delicate Rose has deliciously strawberry laced aromas followed by a seductive palate of crisp, juicy, creamy (Italy)

Luberon Rosé 2023 Famille Perrin @ £22.50

The fragrant nose reveals hints of red fruit and cherries. Lively and long in the mouth, it is very aromatic with great acidity that brings freshness. (France)

White Wines

Bourgogne Chardonnay 2022 Dom. Fournillon @ £31.80

This Bourgogne Chardonnay is from vineyards near Chablis and bears all the hallmarks of it; steely, lemony, fine and elegant. (France)

Sancerre Blanc 2023 Dom. Noel et Jean-Luc Raimbault @ £43.40

Exemplary Sancerre which we import directly from the Loire Valley ourselves. Linear, mineral driven, citrusy, with a slight herbal edge, and a tangy finish. Everything you could possibly want in a glass. (France)

Red Wines

Ch. Franc Baudron 2019 Montagne Saint-Emilion, Cert. Organic @ £33.60

Bright and intense in colour with aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry and oak notes. Well balanced, powerful and velvety. (France)

Chateauneuf du Pape Rouge 2022 Vieux Chemin Ch. Fargueirol @ £51.80

Cracking value Chateauneuf from Chateau Fargueirol, whose single varietal Chateauneufs are rightly praised as some of the most exciting wines from the region. Easy to drink young and made in a fruit forward, accessible Grenache-y style. (France)



Homerton College Port @ £31.50

This famous Port house's best vineyard makes great wines with distinctive aromas of mint and violet with intense concentration and fine peppery tannins. (Portugal)

Smith Woodhouse 2013 Madalena Vintage Port @ £72.60

The small A-rated Madalena vineyard provides the principal component in "declared" Smith Woodhouse Vintage Ports. Rich opulent Vintage Port. Berry fruit aromas, hints of chocolate and mint balanced by fine and elegant tannins. Very long and complex. (Portugal)

Monbazillac 2014 Château de Géraud @ £32.10

Old vines of 50+ years are used to make this golden aromatic dessert wine which shows botrytis aromas of smoke, marmalade, honey. A good but not very high level of residual sugar and bright acidity make for a delicious and easy to drink wine to match with fruit desserts, pastries and blue cheeses.
